
We were delighted to have you attend our Republican National Committee Kick-off Reception on January 22, 2004. You can also assist by informing us of any Catholic-related events that are occurring in your area. We want to demonstrate to the Catholic community the President's steadfast support for Catholic values. which you can photocopy and use to enroll new Catholic Team Leaders throughout the country. Once you have done so, please fax or mail the sign-up sheets to my attention. As an alternative, you can also have new Catholic Team Leaders register online at www.gopteamleader.com. Once you register as a Team Leader, you can specify your designation as a Catholic Team Leader. We also encourage you to forward Catholic Team Leader messages to your contects via e-mail. The Catholic Team Leader program will ensure that Catholic leaders throughout the nation receive our latest campaign updates.

Finally, through our state surrogate events, we will be looking to identify individuals willing to serve as Parish Coordinators. Parish Coordinators will agree to conduct a voter registration drive at their parish and distribute voter education materials prior to the 2004 elections. Currently, Democrat-aligned third party groups are raising tens of millions of dollars to fund their get-out-the-vote operations. For this reason, it is critically important in the 2004 election that mithful Catholics turn out to vote in record number. Your support of this project will ensure that outcome.
